# Savings Service Tariff

This tariff gives details of the charges payable in connection with our savings accounts.

## Passbook Replacement

£5

This fee will be charged if more than one replacement passbook is issued within 12 months.

## Returned Cheque

£4

When a cheque is paid into your savings account is returned by the bank unpaid, we charge this fee to cover our administration costs and bank charges.

## Stopped Cheque

£10

This fee covers our administration costs and bank charges. If you need to place a stop on a cheque drawn from your account due to it being lost, stolen or destroyed. A replacement cheque will be issued made payable to the original payee.

## Same Day Electronic Transfer amounts up to £100,000

No charge

A same day transfer to another UK bank account in your name. The minimum amount that can be transferred is £50. Signed requests must be made by 3.00pm. Electronic transfers to your personal bank account can also be arranged via our online 'My Accounts' facility, once you have registered.

## Same Day Electronic Transfer amounts over £100,000

£11

This covers administration and bank charges when you request a same day withdrawal to another UK bank account in your name. Signed requests must be made by 3.00pm.
